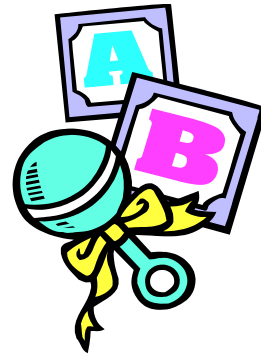


Adolescent Parenting Program

The Adolescent Parenting Program (APP) is a case management program that assists pregnant and parenting teens with:

- High school graduation or GED completion
- Developing future education/employment plans
- Learning pre-employment skills such as job hunting, resume writing, completing job applications and interviewing
- Learning about child development
- Enhancing parenting skills
- Obtaining healthcare for self and child
- Delaying second pregnancy
- Building life skills such as decision-making, budgeting, dietary planning, shopping skills, and utilizing appropriate community resources
- Finding individual or family counseling, if needed

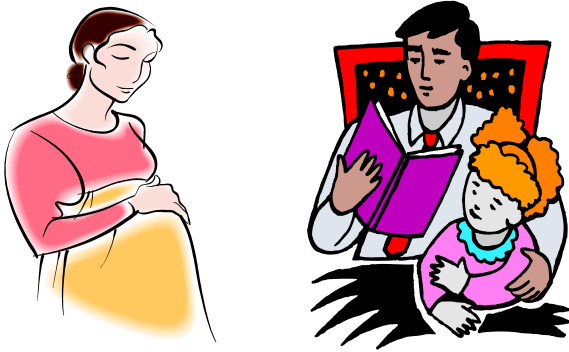
Adolescent Parenting Program (APP or AP²)

We can help!!!



TPPI is a free service designed to assist pregnant and parenting teens in fulfilling their potential and being successful in both their personal lives and in parenting their children.

Program Components

- *Case management to link teen with community resources (financial assistance, medical assistance, daycare, etc.)*
- *In-home visits*
- *On-site field trips*
- *Incentives and Rewards*
- *Parenting skills using the Parents as Teachers model and other evidence-based curricula.*
- *Advocating for the teen*
- *Arranging transportation for medical appointments as needed*
- *Monthly Peer Support meetings with other pregnant/parenting teens addressing topics relevant to their situation*
- *Child care available for Monthly Peer Support meetings*
- *Mentoring Program to provide teen with an additional role model and community support*



Eligibility

- *Must be enrolled in school (middle school, high school) or a GED program*
- *Must only have one pregnancy or child*
- *Must be committed to participate with monthly in-home visits and monthly Peer Support meetings, learning parenting skills, staying in school, and delaying further pregnancies.*
- *This is a **FREE** service.*
